

Admissions

Choosing your child's primary school is a very important decision and at Ferry Lane we aim to help and support parents with this process. It is very important that you find out as much as possible about the schools you are considering for your child so that you choose the school which is right for them. We strongly encourage parents to visit schools during the working day to get an idea of the atmosphere and ethos that your child would experience. At Ferry Lane we make individual appointments for parents to be shown around our school, during this tour parents can ask any questions and find out more information.

Reception Admissions

All children in Haringey enter the reception class in the September of the school year in which they will be five. Some children will move up from local Nurseries and others come from home or child minders. We have places for 30 reception children each year.

Parents should contact their local authority to make an application. Residents of Haringey can make an application online by going to:

The admissions criteria are based on award of Educational Health Care Plans, children looked after by the local authority or post adoption, siblings already at school and distance from school (in that order of priority).

Applications for the September 2016 intake should have been made by January 15th 2016
